Subject: **WHAT IS PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

LEARNING OBJECTIVE: Students will understand what is meant by ‘personal information’.

RESOURCES: information about famous people (from magazines, books, Internet); PowerPoint slide/ Slide 1: Personal information; Pupil handout: Personal information profile (Handout 1); pens.

Extra handout: ‘Who needs to know what?’

INTRODUCTION: Tell the class that they will be considering personal information. Ask what they think personal information is. Write down their ideas. Show the class the definition of ‘personal information’ (PowerPoint 1/Slide 1).

ACTIVITY: Children choose a famous person and write down as much personal information as they can; they complete “Pupil sheet: Personal information profile” with found information.

DISCUSSION: Ask pupils: If they were the famous person, would they mind that the information was known? What problems may come out when people know your address? Which pieces of information should be kept safe? Why?

EXTENSION: Pupils receive a handout: ‘Who needs to know what?’ and they decide/tick their ideas. After all they share their ideas with the rest of classmates. They use phrases: *In my opinion....* , *I think a doctor doesn’t need to know my email*, etc.
